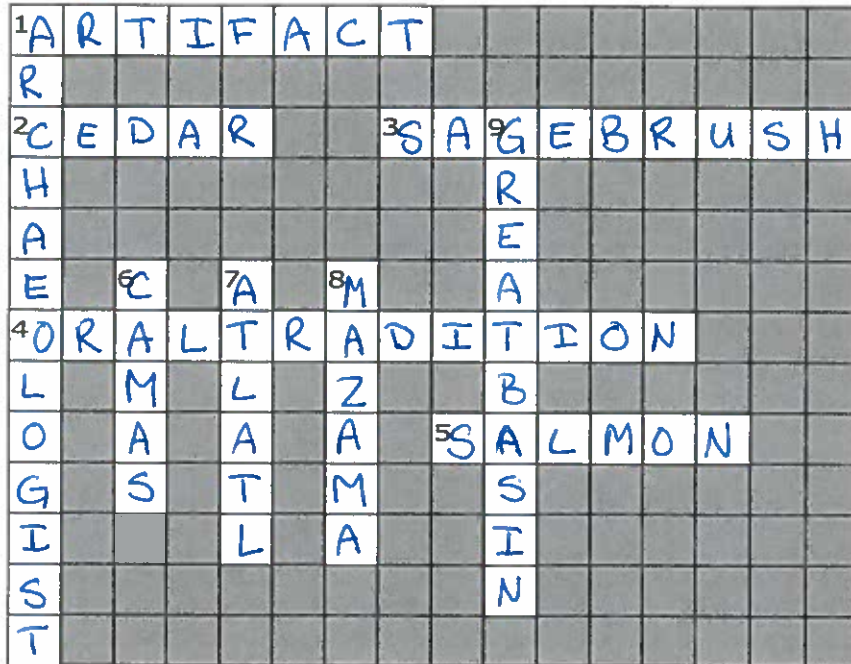


Crossword Puzzle Challenge

Across

- The world's oldest shoes, on display at the museum, are made from the bark of this plant.
- A story handed down from one generation to the next (two words).
- A kind of fish caught and traded by people along the Columbia Plateau.

Down

- A scientist who studies clues to the past.
- A purple flower whose root was an important food source.
- A tool used to launch spears or darts. It was used before the bow and arrow were invented.
- The name of the mountain that blew up and collapsed to form Crater Lake.
- The region of Oregon where people made houses of tule and willow. This area is sometimes called a high desert (two words).
