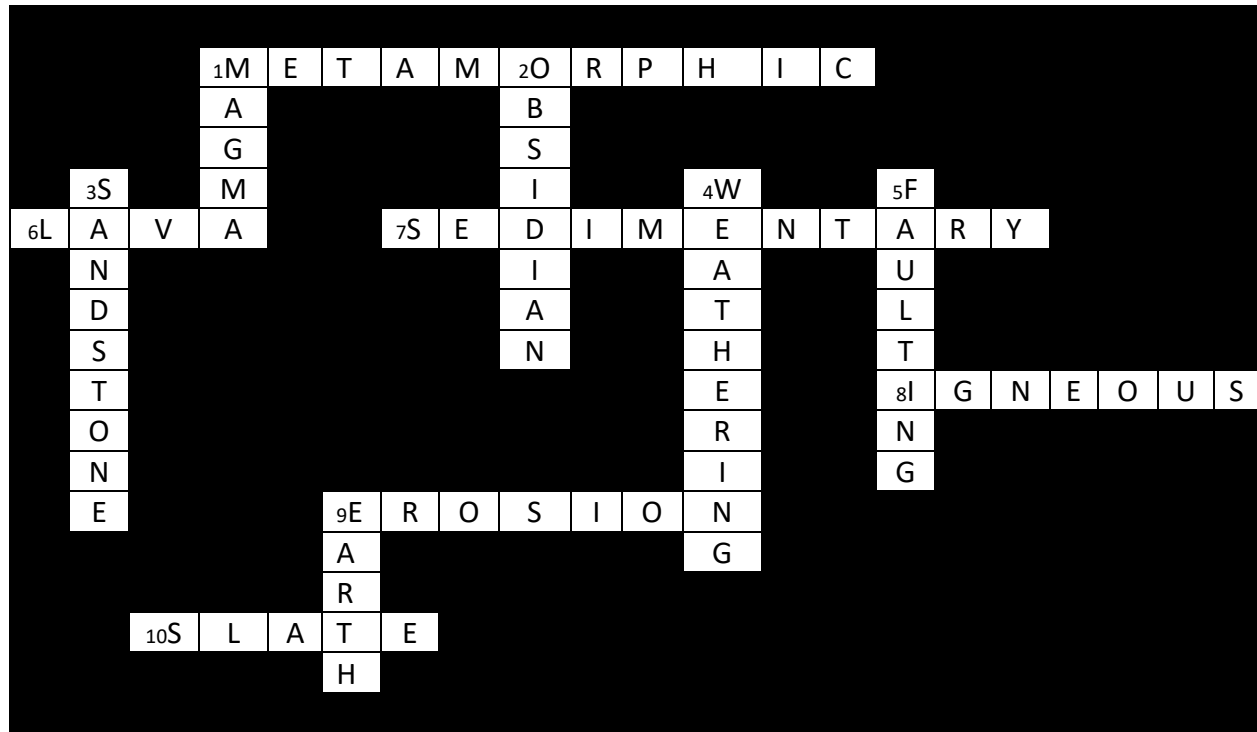


Geology Crossword Puzzle

Perfect your geologic vocabulary! Solve the clues below using the word bank.



Across:

- Intense heat and pressure from below the Earth's surface forms this type of rock.
- A red-hot liquid that flows *above* the Earth's surface.
- Soil and sediments hardening over time forms this type of rock.
- This rock forms from cooled lava.
- The sweeping away of weathered rock particles by water, wind, ice, and gravity.
- A metamorphic rock that forms from intense heat and pressure below the Earth's surface.

Down:

- A red-hot liquid *below* the Earth's surface.
- This is an igneous rock that forms from cooled magma.
- A sedimentary rock that forms from sand-size minerals or rock grains.
- The breaking down of rocks through wind, water, animals, chemicals, and plants.
- This occurs when there is a break below the Earth's surface and movement occurs.
- The planet we live on.
