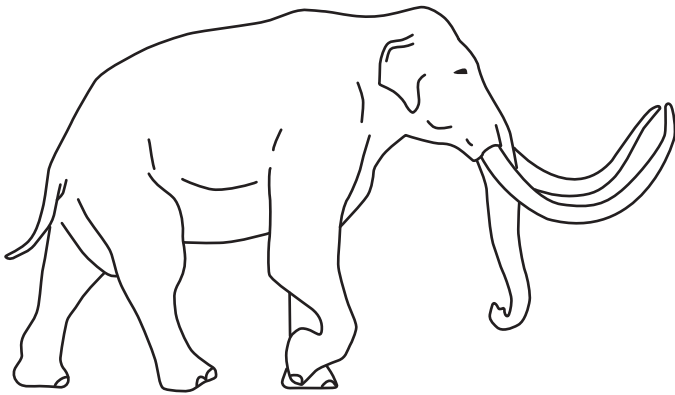




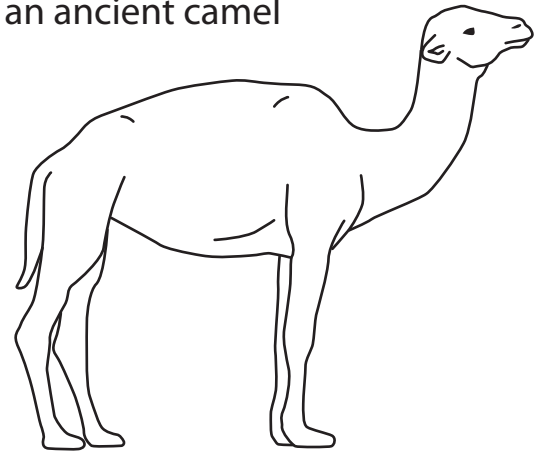
STOMP

like a mammoth



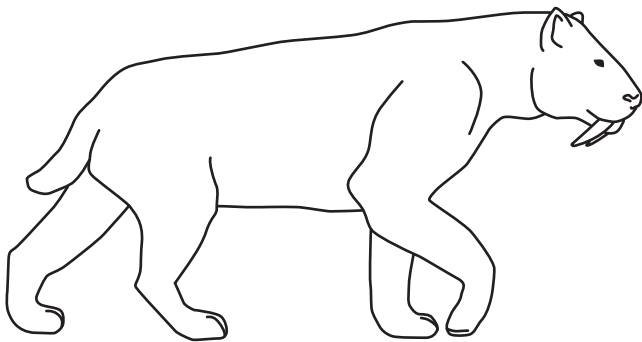
STRETCH

like an ancient camel



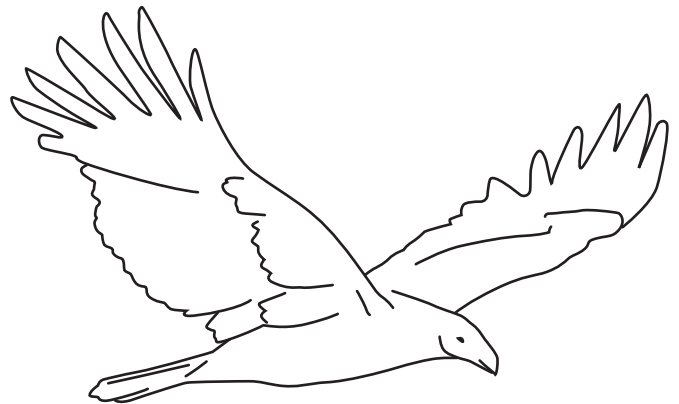
LEAP

like a sabertoothed cat



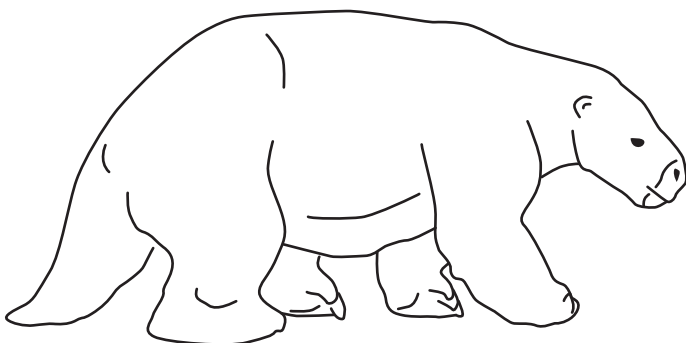
FLAP

like a monster bird



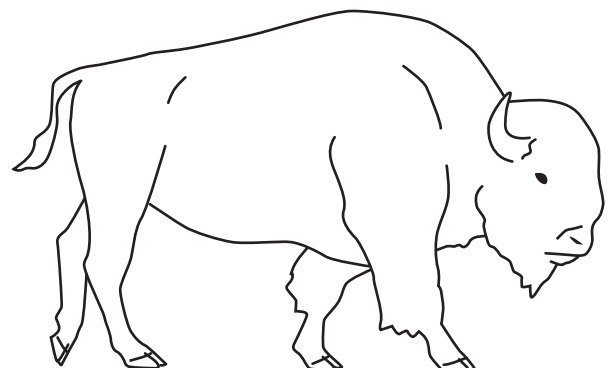
STROLL

Western camels were herbivores, or plant-eaters. They stretched their long necks to reach and grab leaves from high trees.
