Blowing in the Wind

Wind can be a powerful force, blowing leaves out of trees. In this activity little ones will be like the wind and move leaves and other natural objects around.

You'll need:

- Straw
- Leaves
- Other natural objects like pinecones, rocks, etc.
- Optional: ruler or measuring tape



What to do:

1. Lay out leaves and other items on a table or tray.
2. Use the straw to move the different objects around by blowing through it.
3. Ask these questions as your little one is moving the objects:
 - a. Is it easy or hard to move the leaf?
 - b. How much wind does it take to move it?
 - c. How far does it go?
 - d. What else do you notice?
