

Butterfly Wings

Butterflies start out as caterpillars and go through a complete metamorphosis to emerge as an adult with wings! With this craft, little ones can create their own wings for their butterfly.

You'll need:

- Coffee filter
- Clothespin
- Pipe cleaner
- Washable markers
- Spray bottle with water or paint brush and water

What to do:

- 1. Flatten out the coffee filter on a tray or newspaper.
- 2. Color the filter with washable markers get creative!
- 3. Use the spray bottle or a paint brush and water to blend the colors. Let dry.
- 4. Twist the pipe clear into antenna and loop around the clothespin.
- 5. Once the filter is dry scrunch it in between the clothespin to create the butterfly wings.
