

Dinosaur Skeleton

Most dinosaur fossils are from the hard parts of an animal's body, like the bones and teeth. Make your own dinosaur fossil skeleton.

You'll need:

- Construction paper
- Q-tips
- Dinosaur Coloring Pages
- Crayon
- Glue
- Scissors



What to do:

- 1. Draw an outline of a dinosaur or cut out a coloring page dinosaur to use as a stencil.
- 2. Cut some of the Q-tips into different lengths.
- 3. Lay out the Q-tips where the dinosaur's bones would be.
- 4. Glue the Q-tips in place and let dry.
