

Fishing Fun!

People today fish using nets, lures, and traps – many of which are based on traditional fishing tools and techniques developed hundreds, and even thousands, of years ago. With this activity little ones can build their own fishing pole and try to catch salmon.

You'll need:

- Item to use as a pole (pencil, stick, or dowl)
- Pipe cleaner
- Large paperclips
- Tape
- Fish template
- Scissors

What to do:

- 1. Cut out fish.
- 2. Unfold the paperclips halfway.
- 3. Attach one paperclip to each fish with tape.
- 4. Make a fishing pole out of a stick, pencil, or other material and attach the pipe cleaner by twisting it around.
- 5. Bend the end of the pipe cleaner to make a hook,
- 6. Set your salmon out and start fishing! How many fish can you catch?
