

Spiral Snail Shell

A spiral, like a snail's shell, is a growing shape. It grows bigger swirl by swirl. With this craft little ones can create their own spiral on a paper plate and add it to the snail.

You'll need:

- Paper plate
- Scissors
- Glue
- Googly eyes
- Snail body template or paper to draw your own.
- Crayons, markers, paint, or other craft materials.

What to do:

- 1. Cut out the snail body from the template.
- 2. Draw a spiral on the plate to use as a guideline and then decorate with the craft material of your choice. Get creative!
- 3. Glue the paper plate to the snail body.
- 4. Glue the googly eyes to the snail.
