Visuals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fewer than the required number of elements/visuals. - Low-quality images (i.e. unfocused, off-topic, distracting). - Inappropriate content (Check with instructor during work-time to confirm questionable content.) 	<p>Create a visual display that represents your selected indigenous culture which includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A minimum of 3 specifically labeled elements of culture (i.e. dress, body art, dance, ritual, social class, religion, geographic adaptations, etc.) . - Two images per element of culture that compare traditional, indigenous cultures to contemporary cultures in the same region of the world. - Animations or transitions that provide additional information or focus to the audience. 	<p>In addition to all Proficient Criteria, the display also accomplishes some or all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Correctly formatted MLA citations for images. - High-quality images, sized and embedded for easy display. - Well-chosen comparison images that feel connected in theme or focus. - Includes references to vocabulary and readings from the unit.
Oral Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Unprepared delivery - Distracting behavior - Inappropriate Word Choice or pronunciation of key terms. 	<p>Present all or most of the group slideshow, meeting the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Speaking tone, volume, and speed allow the audience to receive and follow information. - Word-choice is generally accurate and doesn't distract the audience. - Speaker has clearly rehearsed the presentation, only a few minor mistakes in pronunciation and delivery. 	<p>In addition to all Proficient requirements, the presentation also meets some or all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Delivery is engaging, with appropriate energy and clarity. - Word Choice is accurate and effective, enhancing the understanding of the audience. - Includes references to vocabulary and readings from the unit.

<p>Written Report</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Does not meet minimum length. - Goes WAY over minimum length. - Does not provide a minimum of information on the required topics. - ANY plagiarism, either direct or of ideas. (Cite EVERYTHING to avoid issues.) 	<p>Create a two-page expository report, based on multiple-sources of research, that accomplishes the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide historical context to the chosen indigenous culture, including origin, , and eras. - Utilize multiple academic sources in gathering your information, citing them in your paper.. - Focus on one aspect of the chosen indigenous culture that shows cultural diffusion in their current nation-state. 	<p>In addition to all Proficient requirements, the written report also meets some or all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Word Choice is accurate and effective, enhancing the understanding of the reader. - Includes references to vocabulary and readings from the unit. - Efficient phrasing conveys numerous ideas in a short format.
<p>Professionalism</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fewer than 2 pieces are ready for draft-review process at first deadline. - 1 or more pieces of the project are not ready at the final deadline. - 1 or more members have unexcused absences on presentation day. - One or more instances of plagiarism are present. (Direct or indirect plagiarism, which includes using quotes, rephrasings, or ideas without proper citation.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At least 2 of 3 pieces of the project are in draft-form at first deadline. - All pieces of the project are turned in on-time. - Most grammar mistakes have been edited out of visual slides, oral presentation, and written report. - Team Contract is mostly up-to-date throughout the project. - Minimum loss of handouts, notes, and other necessary materials. 	<p>In addition to meeting all Proficient criteria, members also meet the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All pieces of the project are in draft-form on the first deadline. - Almost all grammar mistakes are edited out of slides, oral presentation, and written report. - Team Contract is up-to-date and followed by members. - Overall project appears well-planned and polished.
