Wolf Mask

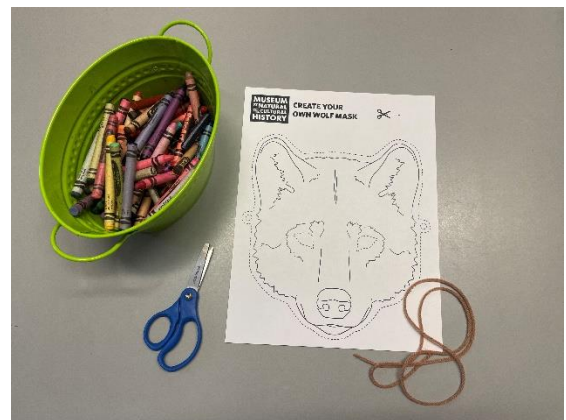
Wolves live in groups called packs. A pack is a family of seven to eight wolves. Young wolves stay in their parents' pack for at least two years before some of them traveling off to join other packs or to start their own. With this craft little ones can imagine they are part of a wolf pack.

You'll need:

- Wolf mask template
- Coloring crayons or pencils
- String
- Scissors

What to do:

1. Color in the wolf mask.
2. Cut out along the dashed lines
3. Cut out the eye holes
4. Punch holes on the sides and tie the string through
