Salmon Life Cycle

Salmon start their life in freshwater rivers and swim out to sea to feed and grow. Then they return to the rivers to spawn (lay and fertilize eggs), which for most is an end to their life cycle. In this activity little ones can learn more about the different stages of the salmon life cycle.

- Salmon life cycle page and info sheet
- Crayons or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Glue or tape

What to do:

- 1. Color in the salmon life stages.
- 2. Cut out each stage.
- 3. Add the stages to the life cycle with glue or tape.
